

Spiral Ring

Online Workshop with Kaska Firor

Explore various weaving patterns as you work on completing this showy ring. Students will concentrate on skills needed to create uniform weaves and on learning ways of shaping woven ribbons into bump-free graceful bends and curves. Students will be given step-by-step instructions for making the ring, and ideas for customizing the design.

Level: Advanced Beginner. Some experience with wire waving will be helpful.

Tools you will need:

- Flush wire cutters
- Chain and flat nose pliers
- Ring mandrel with holder
- Vinyl jaw pliers
- Needle tool
- Ruler
- Permanent marker
- Painters' tape
- Magnification recommended
- Patina such as liver of sulfur, #0000 steel wool (optional)
- Tumbler with stainless steel shot or polishing cloth (optional)
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Materials you will need if you have not ordered a kit:

- 4 pieces 16" long of 18g soft round wire
- 20ft 26g soft round wire
- 2 bobbins to wind your weaving wire on (if you have them)
- 2 pieces 8" long of 18g soft round wire (to practice spiraling)
